The aim of this challenge is to allow the older Joey Scout (must be 7½ years of age to do the Promise Challenge) to gain a greater understanding of the Promise and Law and to learn about B-P and the history of Scouting.

The Promise Challenge must be the best work that the Joey Scout can do. As this is the highest award in the Joey Scout section, it is expected that the presentation of the challenge should be of an appropriate standard. NSW Branch has advised that the Promise Challenge should be presented in a slip in folder. A presentation on cardboard is also acceptable.

Photographs of the Joey Scout carrying out the service component of this challenge should also be included.

This application form must submitted with;

- 1) Requirements Checklist. (Form from GWSJoeys; or Orange Card from the Scouts Shop).
- 2) Cash or Cheque (Payable to Scouts Australia) for \$5.
- 3) Joeys Promise Challenge.
